Erw Groes Family Centre is an 11 flat Project in Holywell that provides high quality short term / emergency accommodation for homeless families. The Centre can accommodate vulnerable families in one of its 11 fully furnished self-contained flats that include a kitchen, lounge, bedrooms and a bathroom. There is also secure parking on site for Residents accessing the Project.





We provide staff support 7 days a week in safe and secure premises, and the opportunity to break free from a homeless lifestyle. We provide a wide range of high-quality supported accommodation-based services for vulnerable homeless people with support packages tailored to the individual needs of our clients. Our aim is to develop people's independent living skills to enable them to move on into suitable accommodation.

Erw Groes Family Centre operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week including weekends and bank holidays. The Weekend Receptionist role forms a key part of us delivering safe and secure accommodation for vulnerable customers with complex needs. This is both a rewarding and challenging role.
